

## TO LOCATE NAMES IN THE INDEX

Determine the first and second Key-letters after the initial letter in the Surname. In the column headed by the Given Name initial of the name for which you are searching, and opposite the Key-letters contained in the Surname, the number of the section is designated where the name will be found. Duplications of the same Key-letter are disregarded. Surnames. not containing a Key-letter, are found in the sections designated by the numbers opposite "Misc." All names other than those not containing a Rey-Letter, are could in the sections designated by the numbers in the column headed "Corps., Etc.", and opposite the -1 -f the name disregarding the article "The".

NOTICE-All firm or corporate names beginning with the name of an individual are indexed according to the surname of the individual. Example: "Gorge Washington Fire Insurance Co." indexed as "Washington, George, Fire Insurance Co." under "Corps, Etc."

All municipal or quasi-municipal corporations are indexed according to the distinctive municipal name. Examples: "City of Pittsburgh" indexed as "Pittsburgh, City of", "School District of the Township of Hampton" indexed as "Hampton Township School District."
