

TO LOCATE NAMES IN THE INDE

Determine the first Key-letter (if but one) or the first and second Key-letters (if more one), after the initial letter in the Surname for which you are searching. The Surname will be f in the section designated by the number opposite the proper Key-letter or letters. (Duplicatio the same Key-letter are disregarded). Surnames not containing a Key-letter will be found in section designated "Misc." All names other than those of individuals will be found in the se designated "Corps., etc." In searching corporate names, disregard the article "The".
